





A Grant for K-12 Teachers Working Cooperatively with Others

Summary

The Meeker Cooperative Electric Trust has made available a maximum of \$5,000 to be used by classroom teachers for innovative, collaborative projects within and beyond the classroom. This \$5,000 allotment will be distributed among qualifying grant applications. Grant dollars will be distributed based on the merit/feasibility of applications received.

Who should apply?

Teachers that work in schools serving students in Meeker Cooperative's service territory. This includes private and public schools. The project **must** include more than one teacher, along with possibly including parents and/or local businesses.

Use this Grant for

This grant is to be used to fund interdisciplinary education. Some ideas for the funds include, but are not limited to, speakers, festivals, interdisciplinary projects, multi-grade level projects, incentive programs, and school-wide events.

This Grant is not to be used for

These funds are not to be used to purchase permanent classroom equipment or furniture. Grant is not intended to fund salaries or to fund field trips. In addition, we encourage innovative ideas, not activities that have already been established.

When to apply

Apply anytime; however, applications must be received by July 1 of each year. A decision will be made in early August. (Funds will be distributed to your school district.) All decisions by the Trust Board will be final.
